**Late Spring Excursion to Brough Castle and the Bowes Museum :
Saturday, May 10th, 2014**

Brough Castle founded by William Rufus in 1092, was built on the Roman site of Verterae. From the 1260s, it was controlled by the Clifford Family for several centuries, and is now an English Heritage protected site. The Bowes contains a vast collection of historical artefacts, valuable paintings, conservation studios and the legendary Silver Swan. The town of Barnard Castle is just a short walk away.
